



Ever since I was an East Carolina University nursing student, I've had a desire to join with Adopt-A-Child on one of their medical campaigns to the mountains of Guatemala. This year everything lined up just right, and I will be able to go! PRAISE GOD!

Adopt-A-Child (AAC) is a ministry that serves as the hands and feet of Jesus in Guatemala and Albania. On a regular basis, the children receive meals and evangelism through weekly feeding programs as well as medical and dental care through one of the AAC clinics. However, on an annual basis, a team of medical professionals – doctors, dentists, and nurses – come to Guatemala to give their time and experience to serve an entire community that has limited access to healthcare. During these campaigns, we get to reach out to the adults in the community who have seen the impact AAC has made on their children. We will be in the very rural mountainous region of Quiche and many people who are served during these campaigns walk for hours to get medical care.

As a nurse, I will be assisting doctors (and possibly dentists) as we provide medical care to the people of Quiche. Care activities could range from pulling bad teeth to pulling a bug out of an ear and restoring hearing. Who knows what healing God could bring just by us making our hands available for His use?

If you'd like to support me in this, here are practical ways to help:

- Pray!!! This will be my first time flying solo (literally) as I will meet up with the team in Guatemala City. Pray that my health would be sustained while I serve others, and that I would be able to travel without any delays or issues. Also pray for Michael who will be "flying solo" with our 3 little men, ages 6, 5, and 2!
- Donate: \$2000 covers travel expenses + room/board for 10 days
- Donate: \$500 towards medical supplies. AAC has been able to partner with local drug reps in Guatemala to obtain medical supplies at discounted pricing. This prevents issues with trying to get supplies across the border while also stimulating the local economy.
- Summary: \$2500 is the minimum needed to send me. Any additional money raised will go towards the Fiery Remnant missions fund to be used as needed.
